RE: Fiscal Year 2022 Aging Schools Program Allocations

This memo serves as notification of the availability of funding through the FY 2022 Aging Schools Program (ASP). These funds are distributed to the Local Education Agencies in accordance with Education Article, § 5-206(f)(2).

In general, the funds can be utilized for capital improvements, repairs, maintenance, and deferred maintenance work at existing public school buildings and sites serving students. These funds may also be utilized to address life, safety and public health risks that may negatively impact the well-being of the students and teachers.

Please see the IAC's Aging Schools Program Instructions for information regarding the application process. The FY 2022 Aging Schools Program allocations for each school system and as shown in Attachment I, totals \$6.468M, which consist of \$6.109 M of new authorization and \$359K from unexpended prior year authorizations.
