Aging Schools Program

Purpose:	Provide State funding to address the needs of aging school buildings.
Application Period:	Varies by year; schedule and instructions are distributed and posted on the IAC website annually.
Minimum Project Cost:	\$10,000
Eligibility:	 Capital improvement projects to improve student safety or condition of the building/site in existing facilities. Additions and new/replacement schools are not eligible. Buildings or systems must be at least 16 years old. Minimum 60% utilization rate of the facility unless justification is provided.
Funding Allocation Methods:	 Allocations distributed in accordance with the Education Article, §5-324(f)(2) Distribution of Grants – Aging School Program. Realignment of project budget up to max LEA allocation. Funds must be spent by the end of the fiscal year.
State/Local Participation:	100% State funding up to the maximum allocation.
Staff Role:	 Projects submitted by the 1st of the month will be approved by the 15th of the month.
IAC Role:	 Approves annual statewide allocations after the legislative session. Recommends annual LEA allocation to the IAC per § 5-324(f)(2) after legislative session. Approves contract awards ≥\$100,000.
Procurement:	 Projects must be under contract by the end of the same fiscal year of the allocation. Education Article §5-112 Bids. Construction procurement methods consistent with COMAR 14.39.03. Project delivery methods consistent with COMAR 14.39.04.
Payment/Reimbursement:	 Reimbursement only; use Form RE 4000 upon project completion. Form RE 4000 due by date set in schedule.
