Active Funding Program Summary

Built to Learn Program

Purpose:	Provides for up to \$2.2 billion in school construction project funding through Maryland Stadium Authority (MSA) issued special revenue bonds and provides for management of the projects by MSA.
Application Period:	Applications are accepted on a rolling basis.
Minimum Project Cost:	\$4,000,000
Eligibility:	<ul style="list-style-type: none">· Existing buildings, new construction, and relocatable classrooms.· Capital maintenance/systemic renovation projects that typically address the replacement or upgrade of a single category of work (HVAC, lighting, etc.).· Combinations of categories are considered when integrally related and justified.
Funding Allocation Methods:	<ul style="list-style-type: none">· Calculated allocations based on estimated bond proceeds are set for Anne Arundel County, Baltimore City, Baltimore County, Frederick County, Howard County, and Montgomery County.· The other 17 LEAs share the remainder of the allocations, capped in proportion to their September 2019 enrollments.· Maximum State Allocation is established for individual projects.· Funding allocations must be used within 10 years of award.
State/Local Participation:	State/Local cost share % applied.
Staff Role:	<ul style="list-style-type: none">· Review project eligibility.· Establish project budgets.· Recommend project planning/funding to the IAC.
IAC Role:	<ul style="list-style-type: none">· Approves project scope and allocations.
Procurement:	<ul style="list-style-type: none">· MSA or LEA as defined by each project's Memorandum of Understanding (MOU).
Payment/Reimbursement:	Payment is processed by MSA as defined by each project's MOU.
