## Active Funding Program Summary

### Nonpublic Aging Schools Program

<b>Purpose:</b>	Provide reimbursement funding for renovations and improvements to existing nonpublic schools.
<b>Application Period:</b>	Varies by year; typically October to late December.
<b>Minimum Project Cost:</b>	N/A
<b>Eligibility:</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>· School buildings 16+ years old.</li><li>· Improvements must protect the school from deterioration.</li><li>· Nonpublic schools participating in MSDE's Aid to Nonpublic Schools Textbook Loan program are eligible.</li></ul>
<b>Funding Allocation Methods:</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>· As prescribed in the budget bill; may change annually.</li></ul>
<b>State/Local Participation:</b>	N/A
<b>Staff Role:</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>· MSDE reviews/approves eligibility and exceptions to established procedures.</li></ul>
<b>IAC Role:</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>· Approves project allocations, consistent with the allocation methodology prescribed by the budget bill.</li><li>· Approves procedures.</li></ul>
<b>Procurement:</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>· Encouraged to comply with COMAR 14.39.03 and use MBE contractors.</li><li>· Projects must be under contract within two years of IAC allocation.</li></ul>
<b>Payment/Reimbursement:</b>	Reimbursement upon completion of Form 306.2 as modified. Schools must have a Federal tax ID number.
