- The colored floor plans must be labeled with room names & numbers (if have) and nsf areas.
- LEA can use their own colors or follow those below, but they must be distinguishable.
- Color plans should only color Teaching Stations and CUS, not support spaces or other spaces that don't count towards capacity as it gets too difficult to read critical data on small-size plans.
- Teaching Stations in the colored plans should match those in the Space Summary and be totaled the same.
- CTE & SE Teaching Stations should be confirmed by the LEA's Facility Planner & Program Specialists.

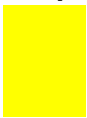
